### **CONSERVATION WORK**

2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month (10-3pm)  
Fresh air, exercise and fun in one of the most beautiful reserves around. Help us restore Shotover's marshes and heathland, along with their associated plants and animals. Tools provided. *No previous experience needed.*

### **BIRDS**

We have 2 bird surveys at Shotover, once a month at weekends.

### **FLORA**

Join our *Adopt-a-Sector* scheme where you adopt a small part of Shotover each year and survey it for flora in your own time. Identification support days provided throughout the season. *An excellent way to practice your identification skills in wild flowers, trees and grasses.*

### **BUTTERFLIES**

Shotover has some rare and exquisite butterflies. Join SW's work in accumulating records.

### **INVERTEBRATES**

There are opportunities to work on invertebrates with experienced entomologists.

It was founded in 1999 to research and communicate the importance of Shotover Hill for wildlife.

We undertake species surveying, research and practical wildlife conservation across a range of different habitats at Brasenose Wood and Shotover Hill SSSI (Site of Special Scientific Interest) and advise on wildlife management.

We also survey further a field in Oxfordshire for the Local Wildlife Sites scheme, BBOWT reserves, Local Authorities and Natural England.

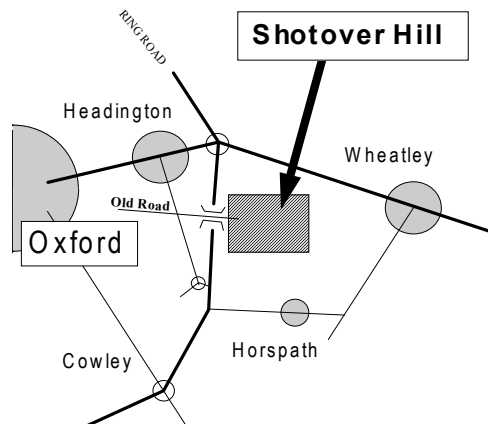
